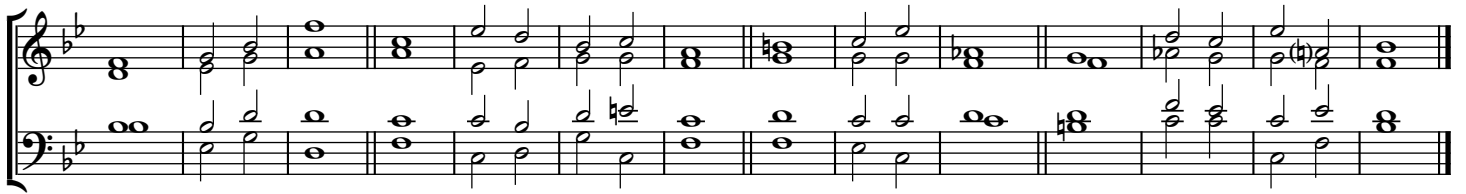


Psalm 19
